

NEW YORK FLYERS CODE OF CONDUCT

1. Always be respectful of others (teammates and non-teammates) at events (group runs, races, socials, galas, seminars) and on social media sites.
2. Behave in a manner that does not put others at risk and does not reflect negatively on the club.
3. Never make unwanted verbal, sexual, or physical contact with others.
4. Never use negative or derogatory language, or make racial, ethnic or gender related slurs when interacting with others at club events and on social media sites.
5. Always abide by race rules, which includes anti-doping compliance; no course cutting; no bib muling; no selling, buying, or transferring of race bibs where prohibited.
6. Never use club resources for personal benefit or personal business gain if your business is not a board approved sponsor or supporter of the organization that does not have a conflict of interest with our organization.

Always report violations of the Member Code of Conduct policy to the Executive Board in writing. You can email eb@nyflyers.org

Membership may be terminated by resignation of a member or by a majority vote of the Executive Board for violations of this Code of Conduct As a member of the New York Flyers, I agree to participate in races only for the New York Flyers, and not be affiliated with any other running team.

When I take part in races or other organized athletic events I will abide by the rules set forth by the organizers of those events. This includes refraining from transferring race numbers to an unregistered runner or running with someone else's race number where that is prohibited. I understand that violation of this requirement is grounds for sanction by the Flyers, up to and including my permanent dismissal from the team.
